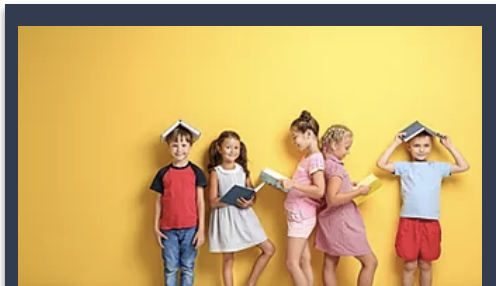
All monitoring is guided by The Story Project Theory of Change

Primary School Summary

Over **15,000** children have taken part in Story Project lessons. Approximately **900** teachers trained. Teachers reported:

- 90%** have seen a positive improvement in children's wellbeing.
- 90%** have seen a positive improvement in children's emotional vocabulary.
- 90%** have seen a positive improvement in children's ability to manage their emotions.
- 80%** have seen a positive improvement in children's behaviour.
- 73%** have seen a positive improvement in children's critical thinking skills.
- 76%** have seen a positive improvement in children's academic literacy.
- 90%** have seen a positive improvement in engagement in PSHE
- 100%** would recommend The Story Project
- 100%** will use The Story Project next year

We also supported **30** vulnerable pupils with access to food and extra support in a Story Project holiday club.

Secondary School Summary

We have worked closely with **five** secondary schools in Manchester. Trialling materials with approximately **3,500** students.

Have developed a new model to suit secondary students better.

Secondary Project being led by Sarah Eggleton, an Assistant Head at Stretford High School.

- 88%** of teachers feel excited by The Story Project vision.
- 92%** of students surveyed felt The Story Project lessons helped their wellbeing.
